Definitions:

Golf Equipment

Golf Clubs, Golf Club Bag, Caddy Car, Golf Shoes, Golf Waterproofs, Golf Hats, Golf Gloves, Golf Carry Bag (for bringing clothes etc.). Excludes members mechanically propelled buggies.

Personal Clothing

Jackets, Jumpers, Shirts, Trousers and ordinary shoes

You are covered at all times but you must take due care and attention at all times. Deductible on Golf Equipment is €75/£60 each and every loss

Personal Liability and Personal Accident

Whilst on the premises of any Golf Club or whilst playing golf or whilst representing your Golf Club on any Club business or activity.

- Personal Liability up to €1,500,000/£1,000,000
- Personal Accident whilst on the premises of any Golf Club or whilst playing golf only due to:
 - Death up to €125,000/£100,000
 - Major Disability such as Permanent Total Disablement, Loss of Limbs, Loss of Eyes up to €125,000/£100,000
 - Temporary Total Disablement up to €125/£100 per week for up to 2 years
- Medical Expenses are covered up to €1,250/£1,000 in Ireland or Northern Ireland and up to €30,000/£25,000 elsewhere in the world
- The 19th . . . every time you get a Hole-In-One in an official Club Competition or in a recognised GUI/ILGU event, the drinks are on us up to €130/£100 (copy of score card signed by Club Secretary Manager is sufficient to make a claim)
